At first he took piano lessons. He studied at the Karol Lipiński Academy of Music in Wrocław taking professor Jan Tatarczyk's clarinet course. During his graduation recital at Wrocław Philharmonic, accompanied by orchestra he played C. Nielsen Concerto receiving the highest grade.

He perfected his skills during many mastership courses under supervision of prominent teachers such as Ron Carter, Dante Luciani, Nicolas Simion, Wojtek Komsta, Ludmila Peterkova, Florent Heau, Ilan Schul, Walter Witek, Jozse Kotar, Alessandro Carbonare, Timothy Phillips, Joachim Klemm, Guy Dangain, Nicolas Fargeix and Lawrence Gwozdz. He was a laureate of competitions in Bydgoszcz, Włoszakowice and twice in Wrocław. He came in first place at the festivals in Szczecin and Krosno. As an orchestral musician he cooperated with Wrocław Philharmonic and as a chamber musician with Wrocław Puppet Theatre. On 23 January 2010 he had pleasure of participating in the Preview of "Ship of Fools" by Sebastian Brant in Wrocław Puppet Theatre. He also played at the International Festival Wratistavia Cantans and he recorded music for films.

He continuously develops his instrumental skills which gives him new means of expression. He is the artist who mastered many instruments. In his collection he has B, A, Es clarinets, soprano, alto, tenor saxophones on which he successfully plays concerts. His repertoire is extensive as it includes many musical styles starting from classics to jazz or latin music.

He also has two-year experience in playing on **passenger liner ASUKA II.**
